The hottest new place in Indy to see some of the nation's best non-traditional art is the Midwest National Abstract Art Exhibition V. This unique show is dedicated to showcasing abstract art from across the USA.

Thirty professional artists were juried into this annual exhibit. They represent 9 states, including Arizona, California, Indiana, Florida, New York, Ohio, Michigan, Pennsylvania, and Virginia. The 50 paintings on display feature a wide spectrum of abstract styles and contemporary media. All art work is for sale, so collectors are urged to come early.

This annual exhibit is co-sponsored by the Southside Art League, Inc. of Greenwood, and The Garfield Park Arts Center, 2432 Conservatory Drive (which is in the center of the park near the Pagoda) in Indianapolis. The opening night reception and awards ceremony will be Saturday evening Sept. 19, from 5:00 till 8:00 PM.
