She received her M.F.A degree at Southern Illinois University Edwardsville working under Dan Anderson, Paul Dresang and Matt Wilt. She was on the staff at Lewis and Clark College in Godfrey, Illinois for 8 years teaching art, ceramics and art history. She has also studied art and ceramics in Italy for three summers and has traveled extensively though out Italy leading art and cultural tours.

Kate has exhibited art nationally winning several awards and honors for the past 15 years, with her most recent award being received from the Mitchell Museum’s biannual show. She was the curator of a national exhibition in St. Louis, Missouri featuring Japanese Artist, Arthur Towata. Her work is represented in galleries in Illinois and Michigan.
